

VERONICA CARLSON

This beautiful former art student and model's aura of innocence made her an exciting ingenue for Hammer Studios. Friedman wrote the highly acclaimed book "Youth in Babylon" and its much awaited sequel "Kings of Babylon" (which will be released later this year.)

ROBERT QUARRY

Aristocratic star of Count Yorga, Vampire, Return of Count Yorga, Madhouse, and Dr.Phibes Rises Again. He starred as a chilling, Manson-type vampire guru in The Deathmaster. For director Fred Olen Ray, Quarry has appeared in Cyclone, Commando Squad, The Phantom Empire, and The Haunting Fear. Being one of our favorites we welcome him to New Jersey.
















HENRY ALVAREZ




DWIGHT SHUNDO




