

In this sequel to the classic At Midnight I Will Take Your Soul, Ze do Caixao (Coffin Joe) continues his search for the perfect woman that will give him a perfect child. See him crushing people's heads in his horror chamber, torturing innocent women with 50 real tarantulas and finally meeting the incarnated spirits. This raven-haired beauty from Britain first appeared in the Bond films From Russia With Love (1963) and Thunderball (65), then donned animal skin bikinis for One Million Years B.C. (66) and Prehistoric Women (66). She was cast as Ralph Bate's feminine counterpart in Hammer's Dr. Jekyll and Sister Hyde (71). Other roles to date include Oliver Stone's Seizure (74), she co-starred with Elvira in Balboa (82), Offspring (87), Evil Spirits (91) and Trancers 2 (91).

JOSE' MOJICA MARINS

Although his films are relatively new to the United States, producer / director / writer / actor Jose' Mojica Marins has been terrorizing his native Brazil for over thirty years. In 1963's At Midnight I'll Take Your Soul, Marins starred as Ze' do Caixão (Coffin Joe)," an evil sadistic gravedigger. He returns to the role in both This Night I'll Possess Your Corpse (66) and The Strange World of Coffin Joe (68). Other films include Trilogy of Terror (68) and Awakening of the Beast (68).

ZACHERLE


Legendary and beloved host of TV's Chiller Theatre and Shock Theatre, Zacherle has been a disc jockey on WNEW-FM, CBS-FM and currently has a Saturday morning radio show from 8-11AM on 92.3 K-Rock. He has appeared in such films as *Brain Damaged* and *Frankenhooker* and recorded many classic songs including "Dinner With Drac". "The Cool Ghoul" released a new music cassette last year. You just can't keep the nation's first and foremost horror host buried.

MICHELLE BAUER

Bauer's first genre role was as the Egyptian vampire princess in *The Tomb* (1986). She appeared in major and minor roles in such films as *The Phantom Empire* (87), *Nightmare Sisters* (87), *Sorority Babes in the Slimeball Bowl-O-Rama* (87), *Night of the Living Babes* (87), *Death Row Diner* (88), *Hollywood Chainsaw Hookers* (88), *Dr. Alien* (88), *Demon Warp* (88), *Beverly Hills Vamp* (88), *Evil Toons* (90), *Evil Spirits* (91), *The Dwelling* (93) and *Dinosaur Island* (94).

JEWEL SHEPARD

Shepard has appeared in numerous sex comedies and exploitation films, including My Tutor (82), Hollywood Hot Tubs (84), Return of the Living Dead (85), Scenes from the Goldmine (87) and Hollywood Hot Tubs 2: Educating Crystal (89). She is the author of Invasion of the B-Girls (and it's soon to be published sequel), and has appeared several times on USA Up All Night with Rhonda Shear.



AL ADAMSON & SAM SHERMAN

During the late sixties and throughout the seventies, Adamson directed a slew of low-budget exploitation films, often starring his wife, the late Regina Carrol, and produced by Sam Sherman. His horror films include Blood of Dracula's Castle, Blood of Ghastly Horror, Brain of Blood, Horror of the Blood Monsters, Hospital of Terror, and the notorious Dracula vs. Frankenstein. Other films include Angel's Wild Women, Blazing Stewardesses, and Satan's Sadists. (Tentative)

TOM SAVINI

Master make-up effects artist responsible for the realistic, grusome images in such films as Deranged (74), Martin (78), Dawn of the Dead (79), Friday the 13th (80), Maniac (80), Knightriders (81), Creepshow (82), Friday the 13th: The Final Chapter (84), Day of the Dead (85), Monkey Shines (88) and Two Evil Eyes (90). Savini has also acted in such films as Dawn of the Dead, Knightriders, Maniac, Creepshow 2, The Ripper, Two Evil Eyes and Heartstopper.

JOHNNY LEGEND


The "Rock-A-Billy Wildman" of exploitation and sleaze began his film career in the 1970's appearing in such cult films as *Teenage Cruisers, My Brekfast with Blassie* and *Pot, Parents, and Police.* His current film roles include *Bride of the Re-animator* and *Severed Ties.* When not promoting wrestling events, he runs Rhino Records and Home Video, which releases such notorious video compilations as the Sleazemania series.

MICHAEL BERRYMAN

Berryman first appeared in 1975's Doc Savage and, as one of the mental patients in One Flew Over the Cukoo's Nest. His role as "Pluto" in The HIlls Have Eyes (77) established him in the horror / sci-fi arena. Subsequent stints include Deadly Blessing (81), The Hills Have Eyes, Part 2 (84), Cut and Run (85), The Barbarians (87) and Aftershock (88). Recent roles include Beastmaster 2 (91), Evil Spirits (91), The Haunting Fear (91), and The Guyver (91).

GUNNAR HANSEN

Hansen's portrayal of "Leatherface" in Tobe Hooper's classic *The Texas Chainsaw Massacre* (1974) defined modern movie maniacs for the past two decades. With no dialogue and his face hidden behind a hideous mask, Hansen pulled off his amazing performance with body language and his imposing presence. He has also appeared in *The Demon Lover* (74) and *Hollywood Chainsaw Hookers* (88). His most recent film *Nightswarm* will be released later this year.

FRANK HENNENLOTTER

Hennenlotter's directorial debut, 1982's Basket Case, rose above its poverty-row budget and amateur performances to become one of the best shockers of the eighties. He took the same potent directing style, adding a strong anti-drug message, to 1988's Brain Damage. In 1990, he proved his flair for mixing horror and comedy with Basket Case 2 and Frankenhooker. For Basket Case 3: The Progeny, he mixed horror, comedy and music.

DAVE STEVENS

One of the top contemporary pin-up artists, Stevens is also the creator of the popular comic book hero *The Rocketeer*, which inspired the major feature film from Walt Disney Productions. His renderings of fifties pin-up queen Betty Page are highly collectible, and brought about the recent resurgence in Page's popularity. He created the cover art for for the Harris Comics collections *Vampirilla: Trancending Time & Space* and *Vampirilla: A Scarlet Thirst.*

BASIL GOGOS

Original, definitive cover artist for Famous Monsters Magazine. Creator of over 40 classic Famous Monsters covers over a seventeen year period. Basil's back and we have him! The king of horror artistry is here with new limited edition art prints for your classic collection. Basil will be signing autographs in the main dealers room.

Joe B. Lansdale - is the multiple award winning author of over a hundred short stories and ten novels. A majority of Joe's work will be coming to the silver screen in the future. His novels include "Act of Love", "The Drive - In 1 & 2", "Savage Season", "Cold in July", "The Magic Wagon" and "Dead in the West". Joe has also scripted three episodes of "Batman: The Animated Series" and co-writes the famed Cemetery Dance column "Trash Theatre". Mr. Lansdales comic related work includes: "Jonah Hex: Two Gun Mojo", "By Bizarre Hands" and "Dead in the West". He's currently working on a new "Jonah Hex" mini series, A "Lone Ranger" mini series, "Wierd Business" and "Blood and Shadows". Joe's newest work includes a short story collection called "Writers of the Purple Rage", a new novel "Mucho Mojo" due in August, 1994 and "A Fistful of Stories" due out in 1995.

Thomas F. Monteleone - writing since 1972, Tom has published 18 novels, 80 short stories, edited 6 anthologies and has written four feature length screen plays. "Tales From the Darkside" and PBS television are some of Tom's television writing credits. Last year Mr. Monteleone won the Bram Stoker award for his novel "Blood of the Lamb". He is currently working on his new novel "The Renaissance Man".

Matthew Costello - Author of "Midsummer", "Wurm", "Garden, "Darkborn", "Homecoming", "Beneath Still Waters", "Sleep Tight", "See How She Runs", novelizations for "Childs Play 2 & 3", "Time Warrior Trilogy" and the new Sea Quest novel "Fire Below". He wrote the CD ROM Hypermovie, "7th Guest" and it's soon to be released sequel "11th Hour". Matthew is also a co-writer on the F.T.L. Sci-Fi Channels' news. New projects include 3 new "7th Guest" novels and a new novel "Countdown".

Steve Bissette - Artist for the new "Image" comic series "1963" and is the co-author of the book "Comic Book Rebels". Steve's earlier comic work can be found in D.C. Comics "Swamp Thing". He is publisher and editor of "Taboo" and has written for "Gore Zone" and the Dark Horse "Aliens" book "Tribes". Steve is now launching his new comic series "S.R. Bissettes - Tyrant".



New projects include "The American Zombie Trilogy" coming out in one volume and a new chap book "Black Sun" (described as a post-apocalyptic Italian western).




