

DAY 1 - WEDNESDAY

Life in America ends as we know it today. We depart our normal, mundane existences for a para-normal experience in foreign soil. Join host Zacherle and the Chiller Theatre friends & fiends as we board our plane as a group. Enjoy the meals (no garlic) and on-board films on our transatlantic flight, or get some sleep (because you'll be up late

DAY 2 - THURSDAY

We land in legendary Bucharest, capital of Romania (first mentioned by this name in a document signed by Prince Vlad Dracula himself in the year 1459). Over 500 years later, we find ourselves in the same unholy land. We are ghoulishly greeted by our luxury coach and led to the Carpathian Mountains at the Transylanian border. Our adventure begins with an Orientation party at the Aro Palace Hotel in Brasov, the finest and fanciest 4-star hotel in the region. In the evening, take part in



a ritual resurrection session: a seance tempting the hands of fate by trying to bring Vlad's spirit back to life. Yes, we've finally lost it. Tonight is your first night in Transylvania, and you may very well be too afraid to sleep alone.

DAY 3 - FRIDAY

We eat a hearty (pun intended) breakfast and explore the city of Brasov, one of three major centers in Transylvania established in Vlad's time. It was in Brasov that Vlad



enjoyed his meals while hundreds of villagers died on stakes at the base of Timpa Hill. We will see the "Black Church" and Farmers Market. We transfer to the Transvivanian locale Sighisoara, the best-preserved medieval town in Europe, and home to witch punishments at the stake, eerie "Clock Tower" and "Square History Museum" (containing the most amazing chilling instruments used for torture you've ever seen). See the true birth

home where Prince Vlad Dracula was born into this world, and explore every room, every nook & cranny. Prince Vlad is still there watching - from a fresco fragment preserved under the ceiling.

DAY 4 - SATURDAY

If you haven't tasted blood yet, today you will be able to indulge in a unique drink: bloodred beer, an exclusive beverage of the Golden Crown Restaurant. This is just one stop as we follow in the path of Dracula, or more accurately, the journey traveled by Jonathan Harker (in the notes of the hero's diary). We may have lunch here at the Romanian

Coroana de Aur, perhaps even ordering the house specialty, the "Robber Steak," Jonathan Harker's ritual meal in the "Dracula" novel. We continue on to Borgo Pass. We come across rivers, trees, swamps and mountains, capturing the essence of Harker's trail. We see the Carpathian gorges, which fit Stoker's description almost perfectly. At the highest point of Borgo Pass is Dracula's Castle. It



is here we will be spending the night, and it is here where we will be celebrating Halloween as part of the gala masquerade monsters ball. You will have ample time to put on your makeup or change into your best costume for this celebration, which includes dinner and a show. There will be prizes for the best costumes within our group, so start planning now.

Kruger Hand-Jive. the Werewolf Watusi, the Zombie Jamboree, the Strangler Stroll, the Boris Bump, the Mummy Macarena, the Lugosi Locomotion, the Electric (Chair) Slide, the Christopher Lee Lambada, Choke-me Hokey Pokey, the Lon Chaney Cha-Cha, and, of course, the Time Warp and Transylvania Twist. You may bring your cameras & camcorders to the masquerade ball, but don't be too surprised if all of the guests do not appear in your photos after you have them developed. Halloween will never be the same after you've partied in Dracula's Castle in Transylvania. Between the scary & provocative costumes and the unusual characters, there will be more head-turning than in an Exorcist movie. WOW! Maybe we can even convince Zacherle to perform his "Happy Halloween" or "Dinner With Drac" classics.

We will do the Monster Mash, the Frankenstein Frug, the Phantom Stomp, the Freddy

DAY 5 - SUNDAY

Awake to the howling of wolves and after breakfast transfer to the town of Bran, home of Prince Vlad's Castle. On the way we pass through the Bistritza River, recognizable from Bram Stoker's novel. We'll drive through tiny villages with violent pasts, and acres of

forest-covered hills, where an impaler could easily kill thousands. We continue our journey to the famous Castle of Bran. Castle Bran is a dark, gloomy edifice towering over a bed of stone, gruesome yet beautiful as a preserved fortress. The castle, built in 1377, is an important national monument and landmark of Transvivania. due not only to the majestic beauty of the castle and the uncanny



landscape, but also to the legend of Count Dracula. In the park area, there is a marketplace where you will find the best selection of Dracula souvenirs and memorabilia in Transylvania. We will then transfer by coach to Bucharest and check into the Capitol Hotel.

DAY 6 - MONDAY

After breakfast we will begin our day with an excursion to Tirgoviste. Tirgoviste's main attraction, the Princely Court of Dracula, a mass of crumbling ramparts and rooms with a few well-preserved sections. We will visit the vaulted cellar under the ruins of the Princely Court of Dracula, It was at Tirgoviste, during Vlad's longest period in power (from 1456-62) that he committed many of the atrocities attributed to him in various



historical documents. There is a tower among the ruins, on which is the lookout ledge where Vlad Tepes would watch the impalements in the courtyard below. Near the Princely Court of Dracula is a bust of Vlad Tepes, an indication of his important place in history. It was also in Tirgoviste that the former Communist dictator of Romania and his wife were executed. Dracula would have been proud. We then will continue to the

mysterious island of Snagov, home of the Snagov Monastery. We have to take a rowboat to get to the island. Snagov is traditionally believed to be the tomb of Dracula. The richly dressed corpse, exhumed in 1931, had been decapitated, a fate known to have overtaken Dracula, whose head was supposedly dispatched wrapped and perfumed as a gift to the Sultan. Back to our hotel in Bucharest for our final fearful fling. Our farewell party includes dinner, and perhaps some surprises.

DAY 7 - TUESDAY

Pack, check out of hotel and transfer to the airport for our return flight back to civilization. Needless to say, if you were smitten and bitten by a local vampyric villager or fellow traveler, you may opt to fly back on your own.
